1. STATE OF THE CITY:

Mayor King went over the goals the city set last year and what goals were all accomplished. She also went over key things that have been done in the city all thru last year. She then opened the floor up to Citizens to make comments or ask any questions.

2. CITIZEN COMMENTS/QUESTIONS:

- a. Citizen asked what Amity uses for ambulance services. Councilor Dyche explained the services. Citizen just wants the city to make sure this is on our radar as the Fire Department is discussing changing services. Mayor King will look into this with the Fire Department.
- b. Citizen brought up concern regarding public safety and no connection with YCSO. She would like possibly one day a week set aside for an officer to be available in the office for citizens. Councilor Rich discussed possibly YCSO setting up an open forum with citizens to meet with them. Mayor King will talk with YCSO about setting up something to interact with YCSO. Mayor King let concerned citizen know she appreciates her bringing up concerns.
- c. Citizen brought up that potholes need to be filled. Especially on Enos Street. Mayor King thanked citizen for concern and will look into where his concern is regarding the potholes and see about having it filled. She also let him know to reach out to ODOT regarding accommodating his route regarding ADA. She also let Citizens know that ODOT is pretty good about responding back to complaints.
- d. Mayor King let citizens know there are openings currently on Budget Committee, Planning Commission and Council.

Mayor King asked Council and Citizens if anything else to add. There was nothing else to add from the Council or Citizens

Mayor King adjourned the meeting at 7:00 p.m.
