This flyer is to inform you of the State Licensing Law. It states that all dogs, regardless of size or living situation, have to be licensed. This law is enforced under Yamhill County Dog Control Licensing Ordinance 692, Section 5.

When To License Your Dog

1. Puppies with their permanent K-9's (Fangs) or 6 months of age.

2. If you acquire a dog 6 months or older, you have 30 days to get it licensed in your name.

3. If a dog resides on your property more than 30 days out of the year, it is your responsibility to make sure the dog is licensed in Yamhill County.

4. You have 30 days to license your dog when you move into Yamhill County. A license from another county in Oregon can be transferred to Yamhill County.

Where To License Your Dog

- 1. You may license at any participating businesses (see list on back)
- 2. At Yamhill County Dog Control (see above for details).
- 3. By mail (see above for mailing address).
- 4. By phone (fax or email rabies certificate prior to calling).

How To License Your Dog

A Rabies Certificate is required for licensing. See below for pricing options based upon rabies expiration. <u>Please note that a license cannot exceed your rabies expiration date and multiple year licensing is optional, not required</u>. To receive a discount for a spayed or neutered dog, you must have written proof from your veterinarian.
